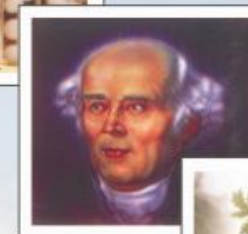

Religious Raghunath Mandir, Peer Khan cave Temple, Ranbireshwar are some of the sacred places in Jammu. Around Jammu **Vaishno Devi Mandir** situated near Katra is one of the biggest religious destinations.
